## Doctor Survey Study



Specialty doctors are worried about prescription drug affordability boards' potential impact on their medical practices and patients.

### CONCERN 1


93%



Did not believe there was sufficient knowledge-sharing between boards and specialty doctors.

### CONCERN 2

93%



Worry that drug affordability boards unaffiliated with state medical boards will make decisions that could hinder patient access to needed medications.

### CONCERN 3

100%



Are concerned that decisions by prescription drug affordability boards will create administrative burdens and reduce patient care time.

Specialty doctors should make decisions about their patients' treatment — not prescription drug affordability boards.
